

AMBULATORY REQUIREMENTS 2009-2010

CORE SUBSPECIALTY ROTATIONS

The core subspecialty rotations are mandatory and must be completed before the end of residency. These rotations are scheduled during your 8-week outpatient blocks:

- Cardiology outpatient clinics (4 weeks) – includes 2 weeks of Pre-op clinic at IMS
- Endocrinology outpatient clinics (4 Weeks)
- Gastroenterology outpatient clinics (4 weeks)
- Hematology-Oncology outpatient clinics (4 weeks)
- Neurology (2 weeks)
- Pulmonary outpatient clinics (4 weeks)
- Rheumatology outpatient clinics (4 weeks)
- Renal consult service (4 weeks)
- Inpatient Selectives (4 weeks) – residents **choose 2** of the following:
 - Cardiology consult service (2 weeks)
 - Endocrinology consult service (2 weeks)
 - Gastroenterology consult service (2 weeks)
 - Pulmonary consult service (2 weeks)
 - Rheumatology consult service (2 weeks)

The remaining outpatient time (10 weeks) can be used for research and/or elective rotations.

RESEARCH/ELECTIVE ROTATIONS

Residents may complete up to 10 weeks of research/elective time before the end of residency.

Research rotations can vary in length from 2 to 8 weeks, and require approval from the Program Director and a faculty mentor via an online application form:

Residents completing research rotations are required to present the results of their research at the Solomon Scholar's Research Day at UCLA, held annually in June. It is acceptable to present work already presented in other forums.

CONTINUITY CLINICS

For residents choosing continuity clinic at **IMS**:

- **One** ½ day per week reserved for IMS continuity clinic during ambulatory rotations
- One ½ day per week reserved for Simms-Mann General Medicine clinic during ambulatory rotations
- One ½ day (Wednesday morning) per week is spent in Grand Rounds/General Medicine Didactics during ambulatory rotations
- Residents will be assigned partners

For residents choosing continuity clinic at **Santa Monica**:

- **Two** ½ days per week reserved for Santa Monica continuity clinic during ambulatory rotations
- One ½ day per week reserved for Simms-Mann General Medicine clinic during ambulatory rotations
- One ½ day (Wednesday morning) per week is spent in Grand Rounds/General Medicine Didactics during ambulatory rotations
