

NEW INSTITUTIONAL T32 FELLOWSHIP AWARD IN CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY

The National Institute of General Medical Sciences (NIGMS)/NIH has awarded the UCLA Interdepartmental Clinical Pharmacology Program a T32 award in Clinical Pharmacology that will cover the salaries of two postdoctoral fellows in clinical pharmacology, with a salary range from \$42,000 to \$51,000 per year for two years.

Start date: July 1, 2006.

Fellows can be post-residency physicians in any area of medicine or PhDs committed to an academic career in Clinical Pharmacology. This new fellowship program supports research and didactic training leading to board eligibility in clinical pharmacology with expectation that boards in clinical pharmacology be taken at the end of fellowship.

Applications are open until April 1, 2006. Application requirements include CV, Personal Statement including research plan or preferably research proposal, and 3 letters of recommendation.
